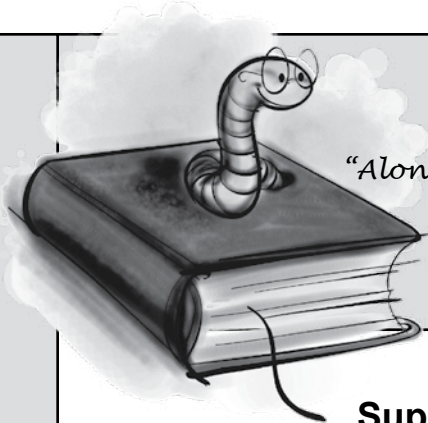

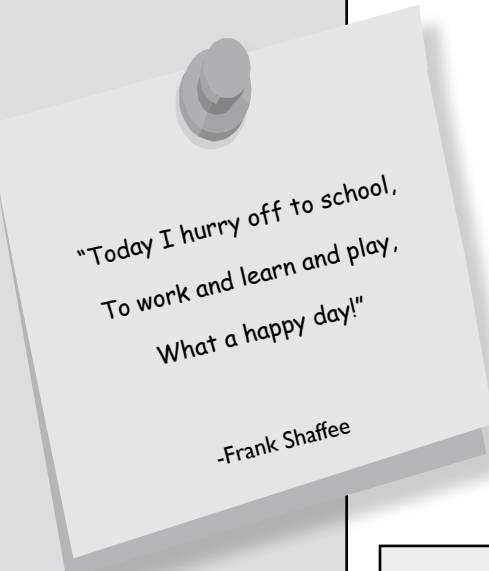

Getting Ready for the Bus

- ☞ A parent or guardian **MUST** be at the stop to meet any **Pre-K to 2nd** grade student.

Get Notified for School Closings & Delays

Inclement weather involves snow, sleet, ice, flood, extremely cold conditions, tornadoes, and hurricanes. Whenever schools are delayed, closed, or an emergency arises, the Honeywell Instant Alert System delivers a single, clear message to the students' parents or guardians by telephone, cell phone, e-mail, pager or PDA in any combination.

In the event of an early dismissal due to inclement weather, students will follow written instructions given to the main office by parents indicating a regular bus stop, change in regular bus stop, or car rider. All students must leave the building at dismissal time.

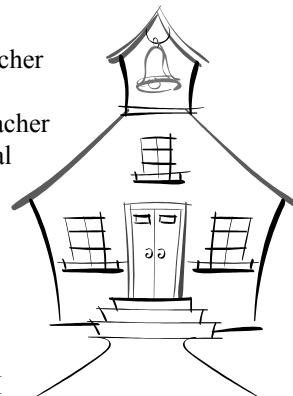
