I love to read, and I want to challenge each of you to read this summer. If you accept this challenge and successfully complete the challenge, then you will receive a medal for your work. You will also improve your reading skills. This is a GREAT chance for you to have fun and read.

A trophy will be given to the Wildcat that reads the most books this summer.

Gold Medals will be given to any Wildcat that reads 10 books (at or above present grade level). Books with more than 300 pages will count as 3 books.

Silver Medals will be given to any Wildcat that reads 8 books (at or above present grade level).

Bronze Medals will be given to any Wildcat that reads 6 books (at or above present grade level).

Certificates will be given to any Wildcat that reads 4 books (at or above present grade level).

Each wildcat participating in the reading challenge will be responsible for keeping a reading log. The reading log should consist of Title of book, author, grade level of book, number of pages in book, date reading was completed, and parent signature signifying book was read.

Students entering into kindergarten and 1st grade may have someone read books to them.

The trophy, medals, and certificates will be awarded at the first academic awards assembly. The Patrick County Public Library has new and exciting books and will be open during the summer.
